

# Two Minute Report



The Monthly Leadership Night was held on Monday, June 6, 2011. Below is a summary of each commission's relevant news relating to their annual goals:

## **Spiritual Life Commission:**

- Discussions will be held with the Liturgy Committee concerning the use of prayer cards and the coordination of the Operation Rice Bowl project with parish Lenten materials. The Commission will explore a possible Holy Thursday pilgrimage to nearby churches for next year.
- The Children's Liturgy of the Word is still in need of additional adult leaders.
- Planning for the Expansion of the Choir Loft is ongoing.
- New altar server training took place in May.

## **Parish Life Commission:**

- Recruitment of new members to serve on the Parish Life Commission is ongoing.
- The on-site parish house-building mission, sponsored by Youth Ministry, will take place next weekend in the school parking lot.

## **Human Concerns Commission:**

- The Commission will work to integrate its activities and vision into the "Moving as a Parish of One" funding and financial model.
- Recruitment of new members to serve on the Human Concerns Commission is ongoing.
- Plans to initiate a committee member "swap" were discussed.

## **Education and Faith Formation Commission:**

- Plans to maintain the CRHP program and to prepare for next year's parish mission are underway.
- Bible Study sessions have begun.
- The "Gift of Time" program has been established; this program provides respite to caregivers in the parish.

## **Stewardship & Development Committee**

- The Talent Drive is going well; 24 inquiries from possible volunteers have been received. Parishioners will be asked to sign and bring forward the covenant and indicate ways they may be willing to serve in the coming year.
- We will be working on the Big Bucks Raffle over the summer as ticket sales will begin in mid-August.
- David Hibbs has agreed to chair our Stewardship & Development Committee next year as we rollout the next development priority: cultivating donations to our capital improvement and endowment funds.

## **Communications Committee**

- A detailed, page by page review of the website will take place over the summer in order to identify updates needed & possible upgrades in functionality.

## **Physical Resources**

- Jim Cronin, from physical resources will complete the bidding specifications in order for the bidding process on the church roof to start next week.
- Mark Kelly from the school board is the project leader on the play lot and Mark Murphy is the architect on the choir renovation.

## **Financial Resources:**

- The funding model was reviewed at the last Finance Board meeting and FB liaisons were asked to communicate model and process to their auxiliary group representative. A follow-up e-mail was sent today and asked auxiliary groups to consider a donation a project on the wish list.
- **Other Business:** Fall Fest will take place on September 18<sup>th</sup>, a Sunday. Our Men's Club has agreed to assist in the planning and will be looking for additional volunteers. No Barnabas football games have been scheduled for that date.
