

Two Minute Report



The Monthly Leadership Night was held on Monday, May 2, 2011. Below is a summary of each commission's relevant news relating to their annual goals:

Spiritual Life Commission:

- Discussions will be held with the Liturgy Committee concerning the use of prayer cards and the coordination of the Operation Rice Bowl project with parish Lenten materials. The Commission will explore a possible Holy Thursday pilgrimage to nearby churches for next year.
- The Children's Liturgy of the Word is still in need of additional adult leaders.
- Planning for the Expansion of the Choir Loft is ongoing.
- New altar server training will take place in May.

Parish Life Commission:

- Auxiliary groups have been asked to communicate their volunteer needs for the upcoming parish talent drive.
- Recruitment of new members to serve on the Parish Life Commission is ongoing.

Human Concerns Commission:

- Plans are ongoing to establish a committee and to invite parishioners to participate in an off-site parish mission trip to New Orleans in November 2011.
- The Human Concerns Commission needs volunteers to serve as members specifically representing the Respect Life Group, PADS, and the parish mission trip committee.

Education and Faith Formation Commission:

- Religious Education is in need of catechists for the 8th-grade program.
- The CRHP Continuation Committee has met and will continue to chart the progress of CRHP at St. Barnabas.
- First Holy Communion for second graders will take place on Saturday, May

Communications:

- The church and church hall is now capable of receiving a wireless signal which will allow for such things as online ticket sales, marketing and electronic messaging, etc.

Financial Resources:

- Easter Sunday offertory exceeded budget by over \$3000.
- The funding model process has been completed. It will be reviewed at the next Finance Board meeting and then the FB liaisons to the auxiliary groups will meet with their group representative to communicate the process.
